

Azerbaijan, Georgia expand cooperation in cyber security

Baku, July 21 (AzerTAc). A group of employees from the Electronic Security Center under Azerbaijan's Ministry of Communications and High Technologies (MCHT) visited the Cyber Security Center of the Ministry of Justice of Georgia on July 7-18.

The delegation, led by director of the Electronic Security Center Faig Farmanov, met with representatives of Data Exchange Agency of the Ministry of Justice of Georgia.
