

2nd CPLP Conference on e-Government

This year the 2nd Community of Portuguese Speaking Countries (CPLP) Conference on E-Government took place between November 25th and November 28th, in Luanda, Angola, on the subject "Cybersecurity".

From November 25th to November 27th, Luanda hosted the 3rd Meeting of the CPLP Focal Points, and on November 28th, the 2nd CPLP Conference on E-Government was held. The first meeting on e-Government took place on November 2013, in Lisbon.

During the 28th of November, representatives from CPLP countries discussed about Cybersecurity, a transversal concern at a global level. CPLP countries are developing their E-Government platform and this subject has allowed the exchange of experiences in a matter that should be even more relevant than ever.

Timor-Leste was represented by the General Director of the Ministry of the Presidency of the Council of Ministers, by the national advisor of said Ministry, Elizabeth Baptista, who leads a study in this area, and a representative of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Cooperation, Natalino Castro.
